## MARINE CHEMIST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Marine Chemist Memorial Scholarship fund award will be awarded to an individual (or individuals) who, in the sole and absolute discretion of the Marine Chemist Association Scholarship Committee, merits the scholarship on the basis of their interest and achievement in chemical sciences, safety and health sciences, or engineering sciences.

To be eligible for the scholarship the individual must be a child, stepchild or grandchild of a NFPA Certified Marine Chemist who is currently an active member, associate member or life member of the Marine Chemist Association. The award is additionally open to children, stepchildren and grandchildren of NFPA Certified Marine Chemists who died while they were active members of the Marine Chemist Association.

The award is limited to students entering an accredited college level institution as a full time freshman only (i.e., high school seniors or first time college students).

Awards may be applied only to tuition, books and related fees that are not covered by other grants. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the academic institution for tuition or related fees. The scholarship may not be applied to room or board fees.

**MARINE CHEMIST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND  
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

All applicants must submit the following.

1. Write an essay (one to two pages) describing your past achievements or activities or both in the chemical sciences, safety and health sciences or engineering sciences. Include in the essay your goals for the future as they relate to your course of study.
2. Submit an outline of your past and present activities in school, your town or academic community as they relate to achievements in chemical sciences, safety and health sciences or engineering sciences. Please provide approximate dates and the number of hours you spent on the activity. Note that all scholarships are based on achievements in chemical sciences, safety and health sciences or engineering sciences and the list of activities should be limited to this area.
3. Submit **two (only two)** letters of recommendation from persons who know you and are familiar with your achievements in chemical sciences, safety and health sciences or engineering sciences. These letters of recommendation may not be from family members. All letters will remain confidential.
4. Submit an authenticated copy of your transcript for the past **two** years including the most recent semester completed.

The Marine Chemist Scholarship Committee **will not** consider applications, which do not contain the required information listed above.
