OCCUPATIONAL, SAFETY AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS (NSI 009-74)


Ref: (a) NAVSEA Standard Item 009-74

1. Per reference (a), "Repair and maintenance employees working aboard vessels, dry docks and piers shall have a valid 10 hour Occupational, Safety and Health Requirements (OSHA) Maritime Shipyard Employment Course #7615 or Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) approved equivalent completion card within 60 days of employment". Deviations and waivers of this requirement may only be approved on a case-by-case basis.

2. The professional qualification and training requirements to become a National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Certified Marine Chemist have been reviewed and determined to meet or exceed the requirements of the OSHA Maritime Shipyard Employment Course.

3. A waiver for the 10 hour OSHA Maritime Shipyard Employment Course is granted for Certified Marine Chemists that hold a current accreditation with the NFPA. A list of Certified Marine Chemists is posted at www.marinechemist.org.
